

## **COLLECTION POLICY**

- 1. Rent is due and payable in advance without notice on the first day of each month and is delinquent after the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month.
- 2. In the event that rent and other charges due are not paid by the close of business on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the month a \$20.00 late fee is charged. If rent is still outstanding at the close of business on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of the month, an additional \$20.00 is charged to your account.
- 3. In the event that a resident draws Social Security or Supplemental Security Income and does not receive his/her check until after the 10<sup>th</sup>, the eviction notice and late fee will be waived. However, if rent is not paid within 5 (five) days of receiving SS or SSI check, an eviction notice will be issued and a late fee will be posted on the account.
- 4. In the event rent and other charges due are not paid by the close of business on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the month, Notice to Vacate-Cancellation of Lease, a 14-calendar days notice will be sent to these delinquent tenants.
- 5. At the expiration of Notice to Vacate-Cancellation of Lease, no payments will be accepted and Notice to Vacate, a 10-calendar days notice, will be sent to these delinquent tenants.
- 6. At the expiration of Notice to Vacate, and if the tenant has not vacated the dwelling unit, an affidavit of Owner or Agent, a 7 day notice, will be filed with the District Court of Calhoun County, Alabama.
- 7. At the expiration of the Affidavit of Owner or Agent and if the tenant has not vacated the dwelling unit, a Judgment will be filed with the District Court of Calhoun County, Alabama requesting the Constable of Calhoun County to perform the eviction.
- 8. Any deviation from this policy such as, but not limited to, a Workout Agreement involving hardship cases, must be submitted in writing and signed by the tenant, on a form available at all project offices, by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month. The Jacksonville Housing Authority will make a decision on any request only after receipt of verification of the reason(s). Any tenant furnished verification must be supplied with 5 (five) days of the signed request. No further eviction procedures will be taken until The Housing Authority renders a decision on the request.
- 9. A resident who receives 4 (four) 14 days notice to vacate in a year will be required to vacate.
- 10. Any date of time limitations, which falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or Holiday observed by the Jacksonville Housing Authority, shall extend such date or time limitation to the next business day.
